Texas A&M University-Corpus Christi is currently accepting applications for Fall 2008 internships in Washington, D.C.

Interns work a full semester in the nation's Capitol and learn valuable skills that can be used in any future career. The opportunities gained while working in Washington, D.C. will benefit a wide variety of students who have multiple interests ranging from medical or law school to pure research.

Some of the primary benefits are:

- 1) FREE D.C. Housing for the duration of the internship. All TAMU-CC students live together with TAMU students in fully furnished apartments in the Washington area.
- 2) Full-time student status based upon completion of an intern portfolio/paper. (All interns are considered full time for insurance and financial aid purposes.)
- 3) A&M-CC students receive training and support throughout the internship including special events, speakers and socials.

To be eligible for this internship, students must meet the following basic criteria:

- 1) Be a U.S. citizen.
- 2) Be a student in good standing at Texas A&M University-Corpus Christi.
- 3) Be enrolled at Texas A&M University-Corpus Christi and have completed at least 60 hours by the semester of the internship.
- 4) Maintain at least a 3.0 overall GPA. Students with 2.8-2.9 GPA will be considered on a limited basis.
