

New State Law regarding course drops

The State of Texas has enacted a statute that applies to students who enroll in public institutions of higher education as first-time freshmen in Fall 2007 or later. Under section 51.907 of the Texas Education Code, "an institution of higher education may not permit a student to drop more than six courses, including any course a transfer student has dropped at another institution of higher education." Any course a student drops after the census date published in the class schedule or academic calendar (which for Fall 2007 is Sept 7th) is counted toward the six-course limit unless specifically identified as being exempt.
