THEA[®] QUICK TEST

Texas A&M University-Corpus Christi offers an alternative test for the regularly scheduled THEA exam, the THEA Quick Test. This paper/pencil test can be used to meet the testing requirement set by the Texas Success Initiative (TSI). The test consists of three sections: Math, Reading, and Writing/Essay. The registration fee of \$29 is non-refundable and non-transferable. Registration must be made online at https://tpg.tamucc.edu/C20207_ustores/web/index.jsp. **A candidate's order confirmation email will act as the admission ticket.**

On the day of the test, you should report at 7:45 a.m. to the building and room listed on the admission ticket (order confirmation). The test will begin promptly at 8:00 a.m. You **MUST** bring your admission ticket and one form of photo identification. If you forget your admission ticket, two forms of identification are required; one must have a photograph (driver's license, ID card, military ID, or passport). Please remember to bring several no. 2 pencils. An examinee is allotted 5 hours for all or part of the test. The scores will be reported to your designated institution in five business days of receipt of the exam. A score report will be mailed directly to you from the testing agency and not the university.

IMPORTANT: Examinees may use a four-function (+, -, x, /), nonprogrammable calculator (with square root and percent keys). **Examinees MUST bring their own calculators to the test administration.** The following items are prohibited in the testing room: any communication device, backpacks, beverages, books, briefcases, calculator watches, cameras, cellular phones, dictionaries, electronic pagers, food, highlighters, notebooks, notes, packages, paper, slide rules, spell checkers, study aids, or unapproved calculators.

* Regular THEA testing will be conducted at Texas A&M University-Corpus Christi on February 27, April 24, June 19, and July 24 of 2010. You must register for these tests at www.thea.nesinc.com or by calling NES at (512) 927-5398.
