Scholarship Application Checklist

1. Read instructions on scholarship form.
2. Complete Scholarship Application
3. Prepare Statement of Purpose
4. Prepare Resume & Collect Letters of Recommendation (if required)
5. Submit application to the Graduate Office.
6. Check SAIL to review Financial Aid awarded to you.

Don't forget:

- Fill out the FAFSA
- Include Student ID ("A" number) on all paperwork
- Check SAIL to review Financial Aid awarded to you.

Scholarships

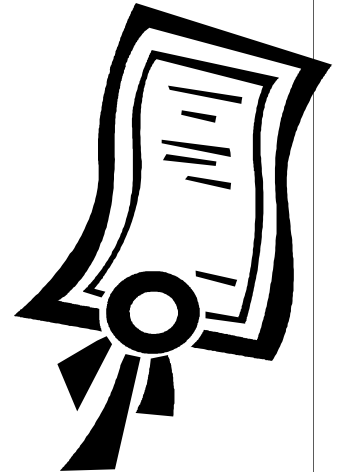
Texas A&M University-Corpus Christi offers a number of scholarships for Graduate Students, which recognize scholastic potential and achievement. Academic Scholarships are based on academic achievements, educational objectives and goals, evidence of leadership and service, and an explanation of how this scholarship will help achieve educational objectives.

To qualify, students should have a GPA of 3.0 or better and plan to be enrolled for 6 hours during a regular semester or 3 hours for the summer.
