ABOUT THE ACADEMY

This high quality, sustained, intensive leadership program includes:

- 2 face-to-face training events;
- Online learning modules - Each module offers 24/7 access;
- Action-based projects –Action learning projects focused on strategic analysis and project implementation;
- Reading and related preparation activities for each face-to-face session;
- Participants for the Leadership Academy will be recruited through a submittal form process;
- Participants for the Leadership Academy sessions will be provided resources and materials related to career and technical education.
- A working breakfast and lunch will be provided with the leadership academy.

THE APPLICATION PROCESS

Participation in the Leadership Academy will be limited to 75 participants. Participants will be selected based on the following criteria:

- Need – is the individual working in the district/campus and responsible for CTE programs;
- Experience – the background and previous experience of the individual;
- Support – how much local support is available for the individual;
- Benefits – what impact will the leadership training have for students, parents, teachers, and other stakeholders.

Those considering the Academy should be prepared for a rigorous program of study, self-reflection and practical application that lasts from January – July.

Submittal form deadline is December 10, 2008. If selected for participation, you will be notified by December 15, 2008.
