

# President's Ambassadors

## Texas A&M University – Corpus Christi

**Purpose:**

The President's Ambassadors represent Texas A&M University – Corpus Christi and the Office of the President by hosting guests of the University and attending special events. Examples of special events include visits by the Texas A&M University System Board of Regents and other dignitaries, presidential receptions, and additional events as determined by the president. Students selected for this position will begin in Fall 2008 through Summer 2009.

**Composition:**

Selection to the President's Ambassadors is open to all A&M- Corpus Christi students meeting the listed requirements. Twelve to sixteen students will be selected to serve for the academic year. The Office of the President will advise the group and coordinate all training and scheduling of activities.

**Requirements:**

- Currently enrolled, full-time student. Undergraduates who will be completing at least 45 hours by May 2008; graduate students must have completed at least one semester at A&M- Corpus Christi at time of application
- Maintain full-time student status each semester while serving
- Have and maintain an overall grade point average of 2.50 for undergraduates and 3.00 for graduate students and be in good standing with the University
- Two completed reference forms; one must be from an A&M- Corpus Christi faculty or staff member
- Demonstrated campus leadership and involvement with a broad knowledge of the A&M- Corpus Christi campus
- Flexibility and commitment to attend scheduled events and meetings/trainings. Events occur throughout the semester including semester breaks, evenings and weekends.

**Selection:**

All candidates will submit an application, two reference forms, and, if selected as a candidate, will proceed with an interview with the Vice President for Student Affairs. Returning President's Ambassadors need only fill out an application form for consideration.

**Schedule:**

- Applications and two reference forms (included with application) will be accepted by the Office of Student Affairs until March 28, 2008.
- Interviews will begin on April 7, 2008.
- Finalists will meet with Dr. and Mrs. Killebrew. Upon selection, new members must plan to attend the President's Ambassador training.
